

Thursday Feb 21st Begins with fine weather fresh trades course N N W saw nothing employed variously painted the starboard boat middle and latter part fine weather course N N by N

Friday Feb 22nd Begins with fine weather at noon saw N. Alistia Islands ran by it to the Westward then steered N N by N employed mending the Gaff topsail mids and latter part fine weather broke out for Baf 44 lbs at 8 AM saw Wellington's Island ran down to it and stood in for the huts

Saturday Feb 23rd Fine weather at 1.30 PM some canoes came alongside but had nothing steered N W at night squalls middle and latter part fine weather

Sunday Feb 24th Begins with fine weather rose men Gibb sheets saw one ship middle and latter part fine weather saw nothing

Lat 10.00 N Long 158.05

Monday Feb 25th Begins with fine weather course N N by N N W saw nothing middle and latter part fine weather sent in the flying jib to mend

Lat 11.10 Long 158.48 E

Tuesday Feb 26th Begins with squally weather with rain at night under double reefed topsails jib and mainsail in saw nothing middle and latter part fine weather sent the flying jib and sent in the jib for mending

Lat N Long E

Wednesday Feb 27th Begins with fine weather desmoyed mending the jib course N N by N W saw nothing at night double reefed the main topsail kind from N E strong middle and latter part fine weather strong trades finished and sent the jib and sent in the fore topmast stay sail stored 2 water casks in the main hatch

Lat 14.00 N Long 148.10 E

Thursday Feb 28th Begins with fine weather sent the fore topmast stay sail course N N by N W saw nothing middle and latter part fine weather mended the mizzen stay sail at 10 AM saw the land the Islands Japan
