

Tuesday March 26th Begins with strong
breeze from N at night a gale was
under stone reefed to sails on port tack
the land in sight Boreas 336 Galls
middle and latter part a gale from N
was laying to saw the land

Lat 32.52 N Long 126.28 E

Wednesday March 27th Begins with a
gale of wind from N was laying to
different backs at 2 P.M. broke
the brace bolt on the main topsail
yard saw the land middle part
moderating latter part fine weather

Lat 32.50 N Long 127.10 E

Thursday March 28th Begins with fine
weather issued clothes to men at night
calm saw the land middle and latter
part calm and light air mended the
fore topsail saw the land

Lat 33.40 N Long 127.15 E

Friday March 29th Begins with
light breezes from S.W. course N.E.
was running along with the main land
for the Straits of Cerca middle and
latter part rainy wind veering to N.E.

Saturday March 30th Begins with light breezes
from N.E. at 1 P.M. weather lighted up
and saw the land made sail and beat
into the Straits of Cerca middle and
latter part was making short tacks off
and on the land at noon was up with
the weather end of the Island

Sunday March 31st Begins with fine
weather wind N.E. was working on short
tacks to windward finished the cutting stage
middle and latter part calm saw nothing

Lat 35.00 N Long 128.15 E

Monday April 1st Begins with light
breezes from N.E. was on the starboard tack
middle and latter part foggy with a
heavy swell wind variable rose men
maintopsail reef tacks and fore lifts

Lat 35.10 N Long 130.00 E

Tuesday April 2^d Begins with
calm and variable breezes with
a heavy swell from N saw nothing
middle and latter part rainy was on
the Western tack
