

Wednesday April 3rd Begins with rain. weather stood in until 2 P.M. saw the main land at 4 tacked off weather rainy wind N middle and latter part rainy with strong breezes was on different tacks

Thursday April 4th Begins with strong breezes from N.E. was on different tacks off land on the land West Shore middle and latter part strong breezes from N.E. was on different tacks

Lat 36° 00' N Long 130° 15' E

Friday April 5th Begins with strong breezes from N.E. at 4 P.M. tacked off shore and doubled back to the ship middle and latter part a gale from N.E. was laying to on port tack

Lat 35° 25' N Long 130° 30' E

Saturday April 6th Begins with a gale of wind at 2 P.M. wore ship to N.W. set the foresail reefed saw a right whale going E.N.E. middle and latter part a gale with rain bent a new fore top sail and set it close reefed

Lat by G.R. 35° 15' N Long 130° 30' E

Sunday April 7th Begins with a gale from N.E. was on different tacks middle and latter part a gale moderating was on different tacks

Lat 35° 20' N Long 130° 25' E

Monday April 8th Begins with strong breezes from N.E. moderating at 3 P.M. saw the land on West shore at 6.30 tacked to the Eastward middle part calm latter part strong breezes from West broke out for water saw several fin backs stood N.E.

Lat 36° 30' N Long 130° 35' E

Tuesday April 9th Begins with strong breezes from S.W. course N.E. at 2 P.M. saw Baglets Island started broad from east between decks wind and latter part fine weather mended the main top gallant sail was working Eastward

Lat 37° 55' N Long 131° 46' E

Wednesday April 10th Begins with fine weather wind S.E. course N.E. at night took in sail and stowed East saw nothing middle and latter part fine weather mended the spinnaker
