

Saturday April 27th Light breezes from West S W ran out of the Straits middle and latter part fine weather stowed the anchors and chains

Sunday April 28th Begins with strong breezes from W W W course N E N E saw 2 ships put sprades on fore top gallant back stags middle and latter part fine weather course E N E saw one ship and the land bearing N W Dist 40 miles

Lat 43.06 N Long 147.08 E
Monday April 29th Begins with fine weather at 1 P M. Saw a right whale. Lowered the larboard boat struck and the iron dunn was fast about 2 minutes middle and latter part fine weather started Beef 4 1/2 bbls and Bread water

Lat 44.10 N Long 150.30 E

Tuesday April 30th Begins with strong breezes and increasing at night took in fore top gallant sail and mainsail fitted the frame to crown's mast course E N E wind S W started the last of the sugar middle and latter part a light gale from S W course E N E saw nothing

Lat 44.30 N Long 154.40 W

Wednesday May 1st Begins with strong breezes from S W course E N E weather foggy put up the crown's mast middle and latter part strong breezes from S E course N E employed making weather cloths

Lat 46.10 N Long 154.55 E

Thursday May 2nd Begins with strong breezes from S E course N E saw nothing middle and latter part variable weather with rain finished and bent the weather cloths

Lat 47.45 N Long 155.10 E

Friday May 3rd Begins with foggy weather at 2 P M a breeze from W S W increasing to a light gale with snow middle and latter part a gale from S W with cloudy weather

Lat 49.27 N Long 162.10 E

Saturday May 4th Begins with a gale from W S W course N E N E saw nothing middle and latter part moderate at 6 A M set the main top gallant sail saw nothing

Lat 52.05 N Long 165.30 E
