

Sunday May 5th Begins with light breezes from S W course N by E middle and latter part calm and light breezes from Westward saw nothing

Lat 53nd N Long 166th E

Monday May 6th Begins with light breezes from N W steering by the wind on port tack saw nothing middle and latter part strong at 7 AM saw Bering's Island ran past it steering NNE

Lat 55th N Long 167th 30 E

Tuesday May 7th Begins with light breezes from Westward course N by E saw a school of killers middle and latter part fine weather wind W S W saw nothing

Lat 58th 50 N Long 168th 31 E

Wednesday May 8th Begins with fine weather wind West course North saw one fin back middle and latter part fine weather wind light from Westward broke out between decks and shooked all the dry casks and moved the full casks forward to enlarge the Hull room

Lat 59th 00 N Long 170th 00 E

Thursday May 9th Begins with fine weather at 3 PM saw Cape Chukotsky steered N N E wind light middle and latter part wind light from Eastward with fog saw the land

Lat 59th 50 N Long 170th 05 E

Friday May 10th Begins with light easterly winds saw off and on the land, incoming Eastward saw several fin backs middle and latter part strong wind N E stood off and on saw nothing

Lat 60th 00 N Long 170th 10 E

Saturday May 11th Begins with light winds from N E trending Northward at 2 PM weather light and clear saw the land and ships and several fin backs middle and latter part fine weather wind N W steering a shore course to the N W E broke out water

Lat 60th 18 N Long 172th 05 E

Sunday May 12th Begins with fine weather wind N W course N by E spoke the Alpha of San Francisco saw the brig Comet middle and latter part strong breezes from N W was steering along shore to the N W E
