

Monday May 13th Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. steering N.E. by N. saw one ship passed several strips of ice middle and latter part fine weather was along the ice

Tuesday May 14th Begins with fine weather ran along the ice finding it made to the S.E. more around and marked back towards the land saw Cape Nararin middle and latter part was working Westward along the ice

Wednesday May 15th Begins with fine weather at 4 P.M. saw a narrow place in the ice worked through to the N. in company with Brig Comet middle part fine weather latter part strong breezes from N.W. was working along shore to Cape Nararin at noon was off the cape

Thursday May 16th Begins with strong breezes from N.W. was working from Cape Nararin to Cape Thaddeus saw strips of ice and 4 ships spoke the Bark Alpha middle and latter part fine weather was off and on the land off Cape Thaddeus spoke the Bark Oriole

Friday May 17th Begins with fine weather was beating along the land with Bark Oriole saw several ships and a few strips of ice middle and latter part clustering with snow at 10 A.M. spoke and gained with ship Florida saw 7 ships was off and on the land and ice

Saturday May 18th Begins with Easterly winds with snow at 10 P.M. Capt. returned saw the land and ice was working to the Northward middle and latter part strong breezes from N.E. with snow spoke the ship Florida

Sunday May 19th Begins with moderate weather with snow was gaining with Florida saw her lower for a while middle and latter part foggy and snow saw several ships

Lat 63.56 N Long 179.00 W

Monday May 20th Begins with variable weather saw several ships one cutting spoke the John P. West middle part strong breezes latter part foggy was laying off and on the ice
