the boat for whales saw several was
off Cape Bering

Saturday June 1st Begins with fresh
breeze was cruising for whales in
the boat the Bon boat struck one
at a distance from the other boats
and near the ship the stern boat
lowered to help but before she got to the
whale the first iron down and cut the
shat war, and the whale got adrift and
went off to windward, middle and latter
part fine weather saw 2 whales lowered
without success

Sunday June 2^d Begins with fine
weather was off and on Cape Bering jammed
with the Elizabeth Quilt middle and
latter part fine weather saw no whales 6 ships
was off Cape Bering

Monday June 3^d Begins with foggy weather
was making short tacks off and on Cape
Bering saw nothing middle and latter
part fog employed breaking out the
main hatch

Tuesday June 4th Begins with foggy
weather employed storing down spoke
the Brig, Manilla of San Francisco and
Florida of do middle and latter part
fog at 8 A.M. saw Cape Bering
started a cask of Bread 276 Gall

Wednesday June 5th Begins with foggy
weather spoke the Bark Anashonker
was on different tacks middle and latter
part foggy with light spells saw the land

Thursday June 6th Begins with fresh
breeze from S. E. spoke the Florida
saw ice and 16 ships employed gaming
middle and latter part foggy was working along
to the N. E. saw several ships

Friday June 7th Begins with foggy weather
spoke the mile was working along to the S. E.
middle and latter part foggy
