Thursday June 27th Begins with fine weather wind Northward was on different tracks saw the ice middle and latter part fine weather saw one ship killing saw several devil fish saw 8 ships started water 240 fathoms

Lat 68°30' N Long 172°50' W

Thursday June 28th Begins with foggy weather saw several ships was on different tracks part of the time aback saw the ice middle and latter part fine weather saw 3 whales they were going quick did not lose

Lat 68°28' N Long 172°55' W

Friday June 29th Begins with fine weather saw no whales employed gaming with California middle part foggy latter part fine weather was steering different courses saw several ships but no whales

Lat 67°54' N Long 171°52' W

Sunday June 30th Begins with fine weather wind S.E. was steering different courses saw several ships but no whales middle and latter part fine weather saw nothing

Lat 68°25' N Long 171°42' W

Monday July 1st Begins with fine weather spoke and gammed with the Adeline was steering different courses middle and latter part fine weather was on different tracks saw no whales saw 23 ships
