fine weather was off and on the ice saw
no whales

Monday July 8th Begins with fine
weather wind S E was on different tracks
saw quite a number of ships but no whales
gamed with the Bark Lydia middle
and latter part foggy was on different tracks
black

wind N W saw 2 ships but they to far
off to get to middle and latter part foggy
spoke and gamed with the Elizabetha Drift
