Sunday July 21st Begins with foggy
weather was laying aback the wind
Eastward light saw nothing middle
and latter part fine weather was on different
tracks saw nothing

Monday July 22nd Begins with fine weather
was gaming with Florida saw no whales
was working Southward middle and
latter part foggy was laying about the ice

Tuesday July 23rd Begins with fine
weather was off and on the ice gammed
with the St. George saw no whales
middle and latter part light air and calm
was working Eastward gaming with St. George

Lat 70° 50' N Long 173° 40' W

Wednesday July 24th Begins with foggy weather
ran to the Eastward along the ice until 1 PM
gaming with St. George saw 4 ships middle
and latter part foggy was working Eastward
along the ice gaming with St. George and
Roscoe saw 3 other ships

Lat 71° N Long 173° W

Thursday July 25th Begins with foggy weather
saw the ice and 3 ships was gaming with
St. George and Roscoe middle and latter part
foggy was working Eastward Broached a bag of butter

Lat 70° 18' N Long 173° 18' W
