Monday Aug 5th Begins with foggy weather was steering West spoke the Gen Scott. Gamed with Sanny middle part foggy latter part fine weather was gaming with Sanny

Tuesday Aug 6th Begins with fresh breezes from S W was gaming with Bark Sanny at night raining took two coils of rope out of a cask and took the kinks out of them 2 Hls of water middle and latter part raining and a gale of wind was on different tacks

Lat 69.58 N Long 164.42 W

Wednesday Aug 7th Begins with moderating weather at 1 P M went on the Northern Tack saw 8 ships middle and latter part strong breezes from West was on different tacks saw the ice weather snowing

Lat 70.06 N Long 164.52 W

Thursday Aug 8th Begins with a strong double reefed topsail breeze from West was on different tacks at 4 P M spoke and gamed with Oliver Crocker broke out a cask of Bread middle and latter part fine weather broke out for water

Lat 70.10 N Long 164.40 W

Friday Aug 9th Begins with fine weather was off and on the ice saw 16 ships one boiling employed gaming with Oliver Crocker middle and latter part fine weather broke out and stowed 30 Hls salt water in the fore hole

Saturday Aug 10th Begins with fine weather was employed stowing water in the fore hole Capt on board the Oliver Crocker middle and latter part fine weather wind N E was steering Westward along the ice
