Thursday Sept 5th Begins with a moderating gale was off and on the ice on different tacks saw 15 ships but no whales saw the Island middle and latter part fine weather was in and out of the scattering ice saw one whale near did not lower

Friday Sept 6th Begins with fine weather was working around the ice saw 40 ships gamed with the Anashonks middle and latter part fine weather was off and on the ice saw no whales

Saturday Sept 7th Begins with fine weather was on different tacks gaming with Florida saw no whales broke out a cask of Bread 348 galls middle and latter part strong breezes was on different tacks saw nothing

Lat 71.55 N Long 175.20 W

Sunday Sept 8th Begins with a gale from N was to the S E until was abcast the Island then luffed to off shore saw 9 ships but no whales middle and latter part a gale of wind was laying to under a close reefed main topsail saw 2 ships

Lat 70.55 N Long 174.40 W

Monday Sept 9th Begins with a gale from E N E was laying to on different tacks saw 3 ships middle and latter part moderating saw several ships

Lat 70.50 N Long 174.40 W

Tuesday Sept 10th Begins with moderate foggy weather was on the Northern tack wind East saw 6 ships middle and latter part light winds and foggy weather was on different tacks saw several ships

Wednesday Sept 11th Begins with foggy weather wind N E was on the port tack saw several ships middle and latter part a gale of wind employed heaving out and stowing salt water was on the Eastern tack saw several ships
