Thursday Sept 18th Begins with a gale from N.W. was on the Eastern Tack at night close reefed the fore topsail middle and latter part a moderating gale saw several ships

Lat 70° 05' N Long 176° 30' W

Friday Sept 19th Begins with a moderating gale was on the Northern Tack gamed with the Seine saw 3 ships middle and latter part fine weather spoke and gamed with Cicero was employed stowing water in fore hold

Lat 71° 10' N Long 174° 50' W

Saturday Sept 20th Begins with fine weather let the Cicero haul a boat load of wood spoke the Seine at night

Lat 71° 15' N Long 175° 00' W

Sunday Sept 16th Begins with fine weather wind E.S.E. was on different tacks middle and latter part fine weather was working S.W. E. saw 15 ships & boiling

Lat 70° 50' N Long 174° 00' W

Tuesday Sept 17th Begins with fine weather was working Eastward saw several ships one cutting middle and latter part variable strong in squalls

Lat 70° 00' N Long 173° 50' W

Wednesday Sept 18th Begins with a light gale with snow weather from N.W. saw 3 ships middle and latter part strong breeze from N. with snow was working Eastward

Lat 69° 50' N Long 172° 10' W

Thursday Sept 19th Begins with moderate weather saw one whale over did not lower saw 4 ships was on different tacks middle and latter part moderate and foggy saw nothing

Lat 70° 15' N Long 171° 30' W
