

Saturday Sept 28th Begins with fine weather was on the N Western Tack wind S W ran 15 ships & boiling spoke and gained with the Florida middle and latter part strong breezes from N W W was on the Southern tack saw no whales

Lat 70° 50' N Long 172° 00' W

Sunday Sept 29th Begins with a light gale from N W W was on the Southern tack saw several ships no whales middle and latter part fine weather at 10 A M spoke and gained with the California saw 3 ships whaling

Lat 70° 27' N Long 172° 30' W

Monday Sept 30th Begins with fine weather employed gaining with California saw 3 ships whaling saw 2 whales with boats after them did not lower middle and latter part fine weather was working N W saw 3 ships take whales saw no whales but those that were taken

Lat 70° 45' N Long 173° 50' W

Tuesday Oct 1st Begins with fine weather saw 4 ships take whales saw nothing to lower for at night lay to make middle and latter part fine weather saw several whales lowered without success saw 4 ships cutting

Lat 71° 00' N Long 172° 50' W

Wednesday Oct 2nd Begins with strong breezes ship under double, used 100 sails saw no whales middle and latter part strong saw nothing

Lat 71° 05' N Long 173° 00' W

Thursday Oct 3rd Begins with fine weather saw 4 whales lowered without success saw 25 ships middle and latter part strong with strong breezes at 8 A M spoke the Massachusetts

Lat 71° 00' N Long 173° 40' W

Friday Oct 4th Begins with fine weather was employed gaining with Massachusetts saw 8 ships middle and latter part a light gale with snow at 8 A M started S E and set the main top gallant sail

Lat 70° 30' N Long 174° 45' W
