Wednesday Oct 9th Begins with fresh breezes from N.E. course S.E. at 3 P.M. was off Kings Island Dist 5 miles saw 7 ships middle and latter part raining and moderate course S.E. & P. Lat 64.30 N Long 187.00 W

Thursday Oct 10th Begins with moderate raining weather course S.E. & P. gammed with Rossie middle and latter part strong breezes from N with snow saw 6 ships all steering S.E.

Friday Oct 11th Begins with strong breezes from N.W. course South 2 ships in sight at night took in the main top gallant sail middle and latter part strong breezes from N.W. course South
