and variable breezes at night a light breeze
from S W was on port tack 3 ships in
sight land bearing South Dist 15 miles
middle and latter part strong breezes
from South to S W with rain at 11 AM
squalls heavy took in fore sail fore topsail
and close reefed the main top sail saw 4 ships.

Monday Oct 14th Begins with a heavy
gale of wind was laging to under a
close reefed main top sail saw 3 ships
middle and latter part moderating rose
new stay sail rises and M. S. Gallant
braces course S by W

Tuesday Oct 15th Begins with fine
weather course S by E saw 3 ships
broke out a pack of Beef 4 bbls
middle and latter part squally course
S by E saw nothing

Wednesday Oct 16th Begins with a
gale of wind was running before it under
close reefed top sails middle and latter
part strong breezes from West and South
saw the land could not fetch through
and more ship to N W

Lat 52^o 50' N Long 171^o 50' W

Thursday Oct 17th Begins with fresh
breezes was on the N Western tack wind
P W saw nothing middle and latter part
fresh breezes from West was laging waiting
for a ship to pilot us to the Soland

Lat 53^o 10' N Long 172^o 40' W

Friday Oct 18th Begins with fine
weather was laging under close reefed
top sails waiting for a ship middle and
latter part fresh breezes from N S W
was on different tacks waiting

Lat 54^o 20' N Long 171^o 50' W

Saturday Oct 19th Begins with fresh
breezes from S W was on port tack waiting
middle and latter part strong breezes
from N W W at midnight steered
S by E squally at 10 AM wore ship
to the North and took in sail weather
squally saw nothing

Lat 53^o 45' N Long 172^o 45' W

Sunday Oct 20th Begins with moderating
weather wind N W W was laging to on the
port tack under a close reefed main top sail
middle and latter part fine weather at 4 AM
steered S by E at noon saw the Fox Islands
and one ship
