Thursday Oct 31st Begins with fine weather employed setting up shooks and fitting rigging course S E middle and latter part fine weather employed drying bone and setting up shooks saw nothing

Lat 30.48 N Long 153.50 W

Friday Nov 1st Begins with strong breezes with rain from N E at night moderate saw nothing took in mainsail and jib middle and latter part fine weather employed drying bone and fitting rigging was on the starboard tack kind S E

Lat 30.84 N Long 153.30 W

Saturday Nov 2nd Begins with fine weather wind S E on the starboard tack fitting rigging and drying bone middle and latter part fine weather employed washing ship was on the starboard tack kind S E

Lat 30.55 N Long 152.20 W

Sunday Nov 3rd Begins with fine weather employed washing ship wind S E on the starboard tack saw nothing middle and latter part light breezes from S W was on the starboard tack by the wind dried the bone saw nothing

Monday Nov 4th Begins with fine weather course S E wind W S W trending West ward middle and latter part squally wind veering Northward course S E employed variously

Tuesday Nov 5th Begins with squally weather wind N course S E employed variously middle and latter part fine weather sent up the fore top gallant yards employed variously
