

Barque Course, from Sandwich Island

Wednesday 11th.

First part Moderate winds and fine weather. Employed in various duties. Saw a ship in the P.M. Middle & Latter parts Moderate winds and fine weather. Employed in repairing hose & main top Sailsails & sails and re-bent them, also in various other duties. Saw nothing. Wind N.E. Course full and by the wind, Southerly. Lat by Obs 13.00. Long by Chron 155.44.

Thursday 12th.

First part moderate winds and fair weather steering southerly by the wind. Middle & Latter parts brisk breezes from E. steering S.E. Employed in breaking out between decks and clearing up. Broke out water. Lat by Obs 11.00. Long by Chron 155.50.

Friday 13th.

Commences with moderate winds and fine weather. Employed in breaking out, at 4. Washed off the decks and pumped ship out. Middle & Latter parts light winds and variable, with fine weather. Employed in breaking out between decks and clearing up generally. Lat 9.24. Long 156.00.

Bound to Coast of Chili

Saturday 14th.

Commences with light winds and fine weather steering southerly by the wind. At 3. finished stowing off between decks, at 4. washed deck, and pumped ship. Middle & Latter parts, variable winds, and frequent squalls of rain. Saw nothing. Lat 9.00. Long 155.50.

Sunday 15th.

Commences with rainy weather, and variable winds, course S.E. Broke out for flour. Middle & Latter parts, baffling winds with much rain. Saw nothing. Lat 8.25. Long 155.00.

Monday 16th.

Commences with light variable winds, and frequent squalls of wind and rain. Middle & Latter parts, winds & weather variable, with some rain. Employed in fitting, Head Riggging, and other duties. Lat 7.55. Long 155.20.

Tuesday 17th.

Commences with light winds and fine weather, employed in fitting head Riggging, & other duties. Middle & Latter parts strong squalls of wind & rain, put the ship under easy sail. Lat 6.05. Long 153.00.
