Tuesday 31st.

Commences with strong winds, and very rugged. Secured. The foreboard Boat to davit heads. Middle & Latter parts stiff breezes from W.N.W. Course, S. by E. Employed fitting Blocks.

Wednesday, January 1st 1868

Commences with strong winds from W. and squally. Course S. by E. At 3. parted footrope to Mainsail. Unbent it, and sent it down for repairs. Middle & Latter parts moderate winds from S.W. Course S. by E. Employed in repairing Mainsail.

Thursday 2nd.

Commences with moderate winds and weather, steering S. by E. repairing Mainsail. Middle and Latter parts moderate winds from S. by W. steering S. by E. by the wind. Bent the Mainsail. Saw a Bark in the S.W.

Friday 3rd.

Commences with moderate winds from S. by W. steering S. by E. by the wind. Unbent the Old Foresail, and bent the new one. Middle & Latter parts light airs and calms. Employed in fitting Sails and Rigging; Saw out Molasses.

Saturday 4th.

Commences with calms. Employed in fitting Rigging. Middle & Latter parts. Light winds from N.E. steering S. by E. by E. Employed in fitting Rigging, and Sails.

Sunday 5th.

Commences with a fine breeze from E. N.E. steering S. by E. by the wind. At 4. cleared off Decks and washed off. Imped Ship out. Very little water. Middle & Latter parts light winds and weather from E. astward, Course S. by E. by the wind.

Monday 6th.

Commences with light winds, from E. with overcast weather. At 4. washed off Middle & Latter parts moderate winds from E. S. by E. steering S. by the wind. Employed in fitting Sails & Rigging.
