

Brig "Daisy" of New Bedford

whaling June 6 1905 - May 24 1906

hunting sea elephants at Kerguelen Island.

1905 Brig Daisy bound to Kerguelen
sailed from New Bedford
took Tug at 10 A.M. took
out by duple light made
sail with strong breeze
from N. N. E. Steering E. S. E.
took hulls in bow blow
he lay at 12 M. rain
took in upper fore top sail
the part clear good luck
out and light pumps at
tender to 60 an

Wednesday 7th this day commences
with moderate breeze E. S. E. heading
S. S. E. put on reef main sail
and but it and middle stay and
middle part strong took in
middle stay sail later part
light took fore and aback
took in main sail took out side light
pumps at tender to 60 an

Thursday 8th First part of this
comes in with light breeze from
N. E. Steering E. S. E. but our fore
top sail fore gable sail

Middle part strong breeze took in
fore gable sail middle stay sail
our sail going to northward
brown enveloped latter part strong
breeze took in upper fore top sail
jib at 4 P.M. lower fore top sail
Wind N. E. Steering E. S. E.
No sides this day
