 sail at 7 A.M. all sail out and
 is steaming N. later part wind
 N. S. W. took in fore sail
 got out water and made stores
 pumps attended to so ends this day
 Heat 28-35 W.

Saturday June 24th
 This day comes in with fine weather
 with all sail set wind N. to N. W.
 Steaming S. W. found the ship
 port pump broke in two however
 put from lower end repeated
 put back. so ends this day
