land set boat in to fish  
came back at 6 with 600  
of fish brook fords steering  
S. S. E. ends this day

Tuesday August 1<sup>st</sup>

this day comes with strong breeze  
the first part later part  
light employed setting up  
fore and main rig and  
repairing main sail  
so ends this day

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Wednesday July 2<sup>nd</sup>

this comes in with moderate  
breeze from E. N. E. to S. E. steering  
S. took in the lower and upper  
top sail to prevent the yards  
and set up head gear  
so ends this day

and light winds from E. to S. E.  
steering S. S. E. employed best  
sails set fore galewit sail and  
haul and other jobs so on

Lat 23-35 S

Friday August 4<sup>th</sup>

this day comes in with fine  
weather light winds the first  
and middle part later part  
good breeze wind S. E. steering  
S. S. E. employed repairing the  
fore sail and best and stripping  
the main mast so on

Lat 24-25 S  
Long 27-28 W

this day comes in with strong  
breeze from S. N. E. steering  
S. S. E. took in fore sail rigging  
so ends this day
