top sail and star sail so on
Lat 36-30 S
Long 01-25 W

Thursday August 17th
this day comes in with moderate
bree from E. first part later
part N.E. steering S.E.
rather rainy and fog set
fore galant sail so on
Lat 37-06 S
Long 01-01 W

this day comes in with moderate
bree with rain and fog wind
N.E. steering S.E. N.E.
got out water took in fore
rail and top mast stay sail
at night so ends this day
no observation to day

Saturday August 19th
this day comes in with moderate
bree from S. to S.W. with rain and
fog steering S.E. by E took in fore
galant sail at night so on
Lat 37-35 S
Long 03-40 E

Sunday August 20th
this day comes in with light
bree first and middle later part
calm blew up light sails
took in main sail so on

Monday August 21st
this day comes in with strong
bree from N.E. steering S.E. by E
all sail out fore and main employed
ship duty so ends this day
Lat 37-35 S
Long 0-31 East
