 Wednesday Dec 13<sup>th</sup>  
 this day comes in with rain  
 and snow sent 2 boats ashore  
 and got ready to start down  
 boats back at 8 P.M. with  
 cold blower so on

Thursday Dec 14<sup>th</sup>  
 this day comes in with strong  
 breeze rain and snow sent  
 one boat ashore and stalled  
 down got towed at 5 P.M. but  
 boat hauled at 5 blowing hard  
 and rain at night so on

Friday Dec 15<sup>th</sup>  
 this day comes in with strong  
 breeze and snow all hands  
 board hoisted in blower  
 and winched stopped work at 6.30  
 so ends this day

Saturday Dec 16<sup>th</sup>  
 this day comes in with  
 with calm started sailing  
 sent two boats ashore at 10  
 came on to blow back  
 finished boiling hoisted in blower  
 stopped work 9 P.M. so on

 Sunday Dec 17<sup>th</sup>  
 this comes in with strong  
 breeze later part blowing  
 a gale all hands board working  
 and storing coals for coal  
 so on

Monday Dec 18<sup>th</sup>  
 this day comes in with gale from  
 W. all hands board working  
 stored down and hoisted  
 in blower so on

Tuesday Dec 19<sup>th</sup>  
 this day comes in with moderate  
 breeze the first part later part a gale  
 from N.W. all hands working  
 one boat off first part of day  
 so on

Wednesday Dec 20<sup>th</sup>  
 this day comes in with light  
 breeze sent 2 boats ashore at 10 A.M.  
 came on to blowed gale and rain  
 winching blower sent all below  
 at 11 then to at 2 P.M. stopped  
 raising got trip at 4 no blower long  
 side at 5 moderate wind gone so on

Thursday Dec 21<sup>th</sup>  
 this day comes the first part  
 with rain and snow light  
 breeze later calm the 3 boats  
 off hunting got back at 8 P.M.  
 with cold and rain started  
 boiling at 12 M. stopped 3.30 so on
