

1906 Brig Daisy lying at Kerguelen
Thurs Jan 25^d

this day comes in with fine
weather started boiling at 5 A.M.
sent one boat in for blubber
came with load at 11 am and
back came on to boiling and
again stopped boiling at 5 P.M.
boat back with out blubber
so on

Friday Jan 26^d
this day comes in with rain
at times. Stowed down boats
board got two starting at 5 P.M.
north to mining stopped
work at 6, raining wind north
so ends this day

Saturday Jan 27^d
this day comes in with rain
one boat went shore for
blubber left took one boat
when hunting boats were
spoiled in blubber and mined
boats all board at 5 P.M.
so on

Sunday Jan 28^d
this day comes in with rain
the first part later part
clear two boats went hunting
came back at 4 P.M. with load
started boiling at 2.30 P.M.
stopped at 8.30 mined all
day so on

1906 Brig Daisy lying at Kerguelen
Monday Jan 29^d

this day comes in with calm
the first part sent two boats
in for blubber started boiling
at 4 at 9 A.M. began to rain
stopped boiling rain harder and
cold stopped raining at 10
M. hoisted blubber and mined
at 8 P.M. the three boats
came board Mr. Currier
came board for good so
blubber so on

Tuesday Jan 30^d
this day comes in with strong
bree the three boats went
hunting back with 4 loads of
blubber started boiling 10 A.M.
finished at 6 P.M. weather
moderate all board at 6 so on

Wednesday Jan 31^d
this day comes in with hurricane
force and rain drizzle boats anchored
boats up at the entrance of bay
in mid channel in 6 fathoms
of water after noon moderate
stowed some oil and
so on

Thursday Feb 1^d
this day comes in with moderate
weather finished stowing oil and
hoisted blubber boat went shore
to get kegs anchored and have
some blubber the blubber full of
turners stopped at 7 P.M. so on
