

1906 Brig Daisy lying at Kargulere
Friday Feb 2^d

this day comes in with moderate
breez from N.W. have 8 boats started
anchor gone when parted have 11
port anchor and side anchor
in 12 fathoms up water 30
fathoms went to minding blower
so ends this day

Saturday Feb 3^d

this day comes in with moderate
breez three boats went shore to get
water and bring empty barke
broke of 16 miles part strong
breez from S.W. left barke and
barke board ahead empty barke
blow for oil so on

Sunday Feb 4^d

this day comes in with light
breez from S.W. to S. boat &
barke of water board and hoisted
all the blower board that was
long side and ahead some water
below and rinsed snow water
at 4 p.m. and cold stoped at 5 P.M.
so on

Monday Feb 5^d

this day comes in with light breez
the first part took 8 barke
of water board and empty ones
stood water and rinsed at
5 P.M. came up a gale
took down the running rigging
read for sea so on

Tuesday Feb 6^d

this day comes in with fine
weather wind to get under
way comes in the bay anchored
in 6 fathoms 30 fathoms
put some barke shore for
oil and snaged up decks
so on

Wednesday Feb 7^d

this day comes in with moderate
wind wind N to N.W. stood
down some water sent 5 barke
shore for water put 9 barke
shore sent down fore gale
sail and yard got out line
shore on Starboard bow and
minding so on

Thursday Feb 8^d

this day comes in with fine
weather the first part middle
and later part with rain
and strong breez bailed out
water blower that was rinsed
put some water below sent
two boats of hunting got back
at 5 P.M. with boat two
boiling 5.30 put line shore
on front board and minding
going on wind N.W. so on
