 Sunday Feb 18th
 This day comes in with finer weather
 two boats of hunting hoisted blower
 and repaired boats back at 3 P.M.
 Did not get 3 barrels of water so on

Monday Feb 19th
 this day comes in with fine weather
 started sailing sent two boats
 hunting got two sailing
 at 8.30 boats back did work
 at 4 P.M. so on

Tuesday Feb 20th
 this day comes in with light
 wind and rain. first part sent
 one boat hunting back at 6 P.M.
 hoisted blower and mended steel
 3 barrels of oil later part blowing
 with squalls so on

Wednesday Feb 21st
 this day comes in with strong
 breeze and rain boats all board
 stored down hoisted in blower
 and mended later part moderate
 wind N.W. so on

Thursday Feb 22nd
 this day comes in with rain and
 sprang one boat hunting started
 sailing stopped at 7 P.M. boat
 board mended blower. ship keeps
 so on wind N.W.

1906 Brig Daisy lying at table bay Kerguelen
 Friday Feb 23rd
 this day comes in with strong breeze
 from S.W. with rain and one boat
 hunting hoisted blower and mended
 boat back to ship at 4 P.M. so on

Saturday Feb 24th
 this day comes in with light wind the
 first part sent two boats hunting
 and stored oil later part calm
 air to blowing and rains and snow
 boats of all night wind N.W. so on.

Sunday Feb 25th
 this day comes in blowing a gale
 from N.W. parted the shore moorings
 and dragged two ships lost ship
 lying with one anchor 60 fathoms
 chain boats have not returned
 storm bound 36 hours out ships
 hinders moving and hoisted all the
 blower in steel blowing harder at
 7 P.M. wind N.W. so on

Monday Feb 26th
 this day comes in with strong
 wind and squalls did snow boats
 have not returned 5 days and 3
 nights of sea placed finished
 mending stock some oil backed
 at fore hold. Packed up starboard
 shore line ship dinge some
 a wind N.W. so on
