first of this 24 hours strong breeze at N N W
the ship by wind heading N E by N with
all sail set at sunset took in sail for the
night middle and latter parts wind light
with pleasant weather all hands employed
in ships duty
Lat 31 = 6
Long 55 = 47

Remarks on Board Sunday 20
first of this 24 hours calm with heavy
fog middle part same latter light
breeze from southward with thick rain
weather with all sail set steering East
No others

Remarks on Board Monday 21
this 24 hours commences with strong breeze at
S S W with rainy weather at 5 pm took
in sail set trisails middle heavy squalls with
rain ends with moderate breeze and clear kept
of south under trisails

Lat 31 = 16
Long 54 = 17

Remarks on Board Tuesday 22
all this 24 hours moderate breeze from N W
Weather pleasant all sail set steering E S E
at sunset took in sail for the night and set
trisails at sunrise best of sea saw nothing
to day

Lat 30 = 44
Long 53 = 24

Remarks on Board Wednesday 23
first part light breeze from N W fine weather
all sail set steering south at sunset took in
sail for the night all the latter part calm
mastheads manded saw nothing to day

this 24 hours
leaking

strokes
first of this 24 hours light breeze from
S W steering S E with all sail set at sunrise
took in sail for the night latter part a
strong and rugged by the wind heading
S S E employed in ships duty saw nothing
this day

Lat 29 = 46
Long 51 = 52 West

Remarks on Board Friday 25
first part of this 24 hours strong breeze
at S W at 6 pm took in sail the ship by
wind heading S E all the middle and latter
part heavy rain squalls the trisails set

Lat 29 = 45
Long 50 = 49

Remarks on Board Saturday 26
this 24 hours commences with light breeze at
S W with pleasant weather heading E S E
by wind with all sail set all middle part
calm ends with light air mastheads manded
saw nothing to day

Lat 29 = 47

Remarks on Board Sunday 27
first of this 24 hours light wind from S W
at 4 pm took a heavy squall from N W
With thunder and lightning and rain middle
part clear light wind latter part same
with all sail set heading W by south

Lat 28 = 57
Long 51 = 25

Remarks on Board Monday 28
first and middle parts calm latter
part light breeze from S W with
pleasant weather saw a sail to
southward the ship steering N E with
all sail set

Lat 27 = 24
Long 51 = 28
