Lat 36 = 58

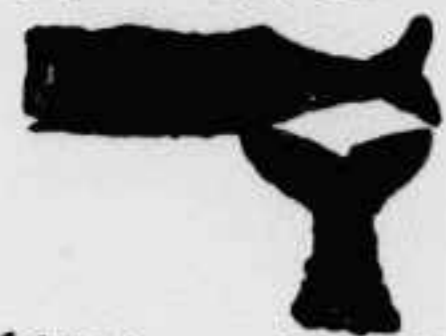

at 2 pm lost Whale by line parting  
at sunset more moderate with weather clear  
at sunrise commenced cutting in at 10  
am saw breach in N E

fore part light breeze at N weather  
pleasant with all sail set steering West  
middle same latter part light wind  
with rain squalls employed in ships  
duties saw a sail to Northward

Lat 37 = 19

Long 41 = 47

## Remarks Wednesday 23

fore part strong breeze from N E  
with dark foggy weather steering N W  
at sunset took in flying jib and  
mainsail for the night at sunrise made  
sail with fair weather at sunrise part  
ship steering to N E saw a breach  
to S W employed in mending sails
