All this 24 calm with pleasant weather.
 Toward two boats for blackfish struck
 one and drewed from him employed
 in mending sails three sails in sight

strokes

first and middle calm latter light wind
 from North by wind heading N E by E
 with fine pleasant weather saw two
 sails to Northward employed in ships
 duty

Lat 36 = 26
 Long 43 = 55

Remarks Saturday 25

190
strokes

light winds at N E with pleasant
 weather at sunset took in all sail for
 the night on a wind heading E by S
 three sails in sight employed in
 mending foresail so ends the day

Lat 36 = 22
 Long 43 = 10

Remarks Sunday 26

160
strokes

light breeze at North weather fine
 by wind to N E with all sail set
 spoke bark union of mallafoisset
 35 bells

Lat 37 = 15
 Long 42 = 18

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Remarks Monday August 27

first of this 24 hours light breeze from
 N with pleasant weather all sail set
 by wind heading N E by E at sunset
 took in foresail for night saw track
 in N by at midnight wind hauled to
 N W blowing moderate breeze at 11 am
 saw breetches in Eastward own for them
 two sails in sight employed in ships
 duty so ends this day of 24 hours

 Long 42 = 38

Remarks Tuesday 28

this 24 hours strong breeze at West
 with fine pleasant weather by wind to
 Northward at sunset took in sail for
 the night wore ship to S W at midday
 wore ship to N E at sunrise made all
 sail at 6 am saw sperm whale
 toward two boats struck at noon
 took him alongside

this 24 hours strong breeze at W
 with rugged weather commenced cutting
 in at sunset started to boyling out
 the body at
