

Sr. Admiral Blake Log Book
May 15 1861

Remarks on Board
at daylight light wind at N^W with pleasant weather at 5 am took our anchor run out of the bay at noon the wind at S^W strong breeze at 4 pm Romans Land bore N^W & distant 15 miles from that we took our departure all hands employed in ships duty so ends this day

Remarks Thursday May 16
first of this 24 hours moderate breeze from S^W with pleasant weather with all sail set by wind heading S by E middle same latter part calm at 8 am toward the look for blackbird

Lat 40 = 39 North
Long 70 = 92 West

Remarks Friday May 17
first part of this 24 hours moderate breeze from W^W with pleasant weather by wind with all sail set heading W^S middle part same ends with strong breeze from N^W at 6 am saw blackbird at noon reef mainsail

Lat 39 = 4
Long 72 = 10
