running all sail set steering S E with
mastsheads mowed past a bark to northward
employed in ships duty

Remarks Sunday May 26
all this 24 hours light breeze from W N W
with fine pleasant weather course S E
at sunset took in sail for the night
at daylight made all sail steering of
to S E mastsheads mowed saw nothing
this day

Lat 30 = 35
Long 71 = 11

Remarks Monday May 27
this 24 hours light breeze from W S W
with light pleasant weather with all sail set
fore part steering S E middle mowed to under
short sail heading to southward at sunrise
made all sail steering E S E saw nothing
to day so ends the day

Lat 29 = 44
Long 69 = 30

Remarks Tuesday 28
this 24 hours moderate breeze from S W
with light pleasant weather the fore
part all sail set steering E S E middle
under short sail heading south latter part
by wind to southward under three lower sails

Lat 28 = 22
Long 68 = 16

Remarks Wednesday May 29
this 24 hours light wind from S S W
with pleasant weather under storm sails
steering N E with heavy swell running
saw nothing to day employed in ships
duty

Lat 29 = 46
Long 68 = 18

Remarks Thursday May 30
this 24 hours light breeze from S S W
Weather pleasant steering of to N E
under tops and mainsail at sunset
took in sail for the night heading
to Westward at sunrise made sail
steering N N E

Lat 30 = 51
Long 68 = 12

Remarks Friday May 31
this 24 hours light breeze from S S W
light pleasant weather steering of N E
with all sail set at sunset took in sail
for the night at daylight made all sail
steering N E by E employed in ships
duty mastsheads mowed saw nothing this
day

Lat 31 = 19
Long 67 = 19

Remarks Saturday June 1st
first of this 24 hours light baffling winds
and calms middle light breeze at S E
scho by wind heading E N E with all sail
set latter part thick squally weather with
baffling winds
