all this 24 hours light breeze from East with  
fine pleasant Weather by wind with all sail  
set working to Eastward saw three sails  
to Eastward

Lat 32 = 13  
Long 67 = 03

Remarks Monday June 3<sup>rd</sup>  
all this 24 hours light breeze from  
Eastward with fine pleasant Weather by  
Working to Eastward with all sail set saw  
three sails to Eastward employed in duty

Lat 31 = 24 -  
Long 66 = 19 -

Remarks Tuesday June 4<sup>th</sup>  
all this 24 hours light air and calms with  
clear pleasant Weather saw two sails to  
Westward man's man's man's employed  
in which duty

Remarks Wednesday June 5<sup>th</sup>  
first of this 24 hours calm Weather pleasant  
middle part light breeze from South  
steering N E by E latter part same  
course N E by N with all sail set

Lat 32 = 00  
Long 65 = 37

Remarks Thursday June 6<sup>th</sup> 1861  
this 24 moderate breeze from S E with pleasant  
Weather steering N E at 7 am saw Bermuda  
lighthouse bearing East distant 25 miles  
at 9 am tacked ship to S W under  
all sail at midnight tacked in shore  
at daylight saw the land bearing E N E  
distant 15 miles saw a sail to eastward

Remarks Friday June 7<sup>th</sup>  
first of this 24 hours moderate breeze from S E  
Weather fine standing of and on at Bermuda  
at midnight wind hauled to S W blowing  
a strong breeze with thick foggy Weather at  
daylight hauled of to eastward at 8 am  
except the mainsail

no other

Remarks Saturday 8<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours commences with blowing as  
gale from S W with thick rainy Weather  
at 4 pm set storm sails ship by wind  
to eastward middle more moderate at 6 am  
made all sail steering S E by E with  
pleasant Weather saw two sails

Lat 31 = 58

Remarks Sunday 9<sup>th</sup>  
first of this 24 hours light breeze  
from Westward with pleasant Weather  
at 1 pm saw Bermuda lighthouse  
bearing E N E distant 15 miles at 5 pm  
boat went on shore at 8 returned all  
middle and latter parts calm and  
pleasant two sails in sight  
so ended the day
