middle light breeze at SW with rain squalls
steering East with mainsail in latter part
rising with light breeze from South with
all sail set

Remarks Wednesday 19
this 24 hours light moderate southerly
winds with fine pleasant weather on a wind
to eastward with all sail set mastheads
manned saw nothing to day

Lat 32 = 07
Long 53 = 39

Remarks Thursday 20
this 24 hours light baffling winds
and calm with fine pleasant weather
employed in ship's duty

Lat 32 = 13
Long 52 = 50

Remarks Friday 21
this 24 hours moderate breeze from S.W.
with pleasant weather by wind to
S.E. with all sail set saw nothing to
day

Lat 31 = 55
Long 51 = 14

Remarks Saturday June 22 1860
this 24 hours light breeze from South with
fine pleasant weather on a wind to S.W. with
all sail set spoke several courses of Provincetown

Lat 31 = 38

Remarks Sunday 23
all this 24 hours moderate breeze from S.W.
Weather pleasant by wind to S.W. with
all sail set three sails in sight

Lat 31 = 08
Long 52 = 18

Remarks Monday 24th
this 24 hours moderate breeze from South
with fine pleasant weather by the wind
working to southward at sunset shortened
sail for the night two sails in sight
all hands employed in ship's duty

Lat 30 = 54
Long 52 = 06

Remarks Tuesday 25
the wind at S.W. with pleasant weather
by wind with all sail set working to
Southward spoke brig Albatross of
Sippican several more sails in sight

Lat 30 = 51
Long 51 = 24
