pleasant ends with light breeze from
WSW steering ENE

Remarks Monday 22
moderate breeze from W with weather pleasant
by wind to SW with all sail set spoke
bark out of fairhaven saw grasspares
two sails to eastward

Lat 37 = 38
Long 43 = 18

Remarks Tuesday July 23
blowing strong breeze from West
with squally weather under short sail
heading SSW two sails in sight
saw breeze to southward

Lat 36 = 42
Long 43 = 12

Remarks Wednesday July 24 1861
blowing strong breeze from WSW
with rugged weather with heavy swell
under short sail heading NNE
at sunset took in fifth spoke brig Lewis
breeze of beverly three more sails in sight

Lat 37 = 12
Long 43 = 37

Remarks Thursday July 25
moderate breeze from WNW with heavy
running swell by to northward with
main sail in saw a breeze to NE saw
three sails

Lat 37 = 44
Long 43 = 05

Remarks Friday July 26
moderate breeze from NNE with
clear weather at noon tacked ship
to SW made all sail two sails in sight
at sunset took in sail for the night
at sunrise made all sail to SW with light
breeze and heavy swell running from NNE

Lat 36 = 35
Long 43 44

Remarks Saturday July 27
fore part light breeze from NNE by wind to SW with all
sail set at sunset took in sail for the night all middle
part calm with pleasant weather latter part light
breeze at NNE with all sail heading NNE two
sails in sight saw grasspares
