first part light breeze at East with fine pleasant Weather
by wind to N.W. & with all sail set middle part calm with
thick dark Weather latter part light air from N. with dark
looking Weather by wind to N.W. with all sail set
master and crew saw nothing to day so ends this day

Remarks Monday August 5
first part light wind at N.W. with pleasant Weather with
all sail set steering N.W. & middle part moderate breeze
with flying jib in saw one sail to Southward latter part
strong breeze at N.W. with squally Weather steering N.W. & E

Lat 36 = 36
Long 43 = 39

Remarks Tuesday 6
this 24 hours blowing strong breeze from N.W.
with heavy rugged Weather under reef sails by wind
heading N.W. by W at sunset took in sail for the night
three sails in sight at day light made sail to N.W. & E
with one sail in sight

Lat 37 = 30
Long 43 = 47

Remarks Tuesday August 7
first part strong breeze at N.W. with rugged Weather by
wind to N.E. with all sail set spoke schooner of Providence
saw breaks to N.E. at sunset tack ship to Southward took in
for the night at daylight made sail wind at S.W. blowing
strong at 10 am reef mainsail one sail in sight so ends
this day

Lat 36 = 05
Long 43 = 17

Remarks Thursday August 8 1861
blowing strong breeze from W.S.W. with rugged Weather
by wind heading S.S.W. under foresail jib two reef
mainsail one scho in sight at sunset took in sail
for the night heading S.W. at sunrise made all sail
heading S.S.W. saw a large break to Southward

Lat 34 = 46
Long 42 = 20

Remarks Friday August 9
fore part strong breeze from West with heavy swell from
N.W. by wind heading S.W. by S middle more moderate
latter part light breeze with pleasant Weather by wind
to S.W. with all sail set

Lat 33 = 13
Long 41 = 31

Remarks Saturday August 10
fore part light breeze at West with pleasant Weather
with all sail set at sunset tack ship to Westward at
midnight spoke A Bunchina Bark of Providence
all latter part blowing strong from Westward at
sunrise reef mainsail took in flying jib 7 sails in
sight

Lat 33 = 20
Long 42 = 26

Remarks Sunday August 11
first part blowing strong from W.S.W. with heavy
sea took in jib and mainsail set main trisail
heading N.W. one sail in sight at sunset took in
foresail set trisail at midnight wore ship to S.W.
wind at N.W. moderate breeze at daylight made all sail
with pleasant Weather
