

Schr Admiral Blake Log Book

Remarks Thursday August 29 1861
commenced blowing fresh gale from SW with heavy sea
at 2 pm took in mainsail set trysail heading WNW at
sunset wore ship to SE at midnight wind hauled to NW
blowing a gale with a heavy thunder squall at daylight
more moderate with heavy sea running the schr under storm
sails heading W

Lat 33 = 18

Long 44 = 34

Remarks Friday August 30
first part strong breeze from N with heavy sea under
storm sails heading WNW at midnight wind at
NE moderate breeze at daylight wind at East light
breeze made all sail steering of NW by W past
a bark steering to SE

Lat 33 = 53

Long 45 = 16

Remarks Saturday August 31
first of this 24 hours light breeze from East with fine
pleasant weather steering NW by N at sunset took in
all sail for the night at daylight light breeze from SE
made all sail steering W saw nothing this day

Lat 33 = 32

Long 45 = 44

Remarks Sunday September 1
first of this 24 hours light breeze from SW with light rain
squalls by wind to NW with all sail set at sunset took
in sail for the night at sunrise made all sail with pleasant
weather at 4 am took ship to SE saw nothing this day

Lat 33 = 42

Long 45 = 28

Remarks Monday September 2 1861
this 24 hours light SW wind with fine pleasant weather
by wind to SE at sunset took in sail for the night at
daylight made all sail to southward saw 1 sail to Eastward

Lat 33 = 19

Long 43 = 36

Remarks Tuesday September 3
first part light wind at NW with pleasant weather by wind
to southward saw blackbird toward for them at sunset took
in sail for the night at daylight wind at NW made sail
heading W at 4 am took ship to westward with wind at
NW

Lat 33 = 31

Long 43 = 54

Remarks Wednesday Sept 4
first light wind at NW moderate strong at NE
latter blowing strong from ENE with rain
squalls all sail set steering NW by W one sail
in sight all hands employed in ships duty

Lat 33 = 28

Long 45 = 42

Remarks Thursday Sept 5
first part strong breeze at East with weather pleasant all
middle and latter parts light breeze steering NW by W
with one sail in sight to southward

Lat 34 = 00

Long 47 = 33
