Remarks Friday September 6 1861

this 24 hours light breeze from SE with fine pleasant weather with all sail set steering West employed in ships duty. mastheads man saw nothing this day.

Lat 33 = 41
Long 77 = 01

Remarks Saturday Sept 7

fore part light breeze from SE weather pleasant all middle same latter wind at South steering W by S employed in ships duty saw nothing this day.

Lat 33 = 10
Long 50 = 51

Remarks Sunday Sept 8

this 24 hours light breeze from SE with fine pleasant weather steering W by S saw grouper.

Lat 32 = 42
Long 51 = 50

Remarks Monday Sept 9

this 24 hours light air and calm from SE weather fine and pleasant steering West saw nothing this day.

Lat 32 = 46
Long 52 = 47

Remarks Tuesday Sept 10

first light wind at SE with fine pleasant weather middle wind at S light latter wind at SW light with all sail set steering W.N.W.

Lat 33 = 00
Long 53 = 54

Remarks Wednesday Sept 11 1861

first part light breeze from S with fine pleasant weather middle wind at SW light ends with wind at W.N.W. strong breeze steering W.N.W.

Lat 33 = 20
Long 55 = 09

Remarks Thursday Sept 12

first part light wind from N with weather pleasant by wind heading W by N at 5 pm toward the Harbor and Waist boats for blackfish all middle and latter parts calm.

Lat 33 = 14
Long 55 = 33

Remarks Friday Sept 13

first part calm with pleasant weather middle light breeze from West heading N.W.W. latter light breeze at SW heading N.W. by W. past a Brig steering to N.E.

Lat 33 = 31
Long 55 = 59

Remarks Saturday Sept 14

fore part light breeze from S.S.W. with pleasant weather by wind heading W by N at 5 pm wind at SE light steering N.W. by W at 10 pm wind at East moderate breeze at sunrise wind at E.N.E. strong breeze at 8 am took in gaff topsail at 10 am next mainsail with thick cloudy weather at 11 am took in mainsail and flying jib set main trysail blowing strong at N.E. with thick weather.
