fore part blowing strong from N E with dark clouds
Weather steering NW by W at 3 pm took in fore sail
at 5 pm hove to under storm sails heading N
blowing heavy gale at N E at midnight wind at
East blowing heavy gale with heavy rain at 10 am
wind at N moderate gale Weather thick and rainy

Remarks Monday Sept 16
commenced with blowing a fresh gale at N at 2 pm
wind hauled to NW blowing a heavy gale with heavy
rain laying under storm sails heading NW by W
at 1 am gale moderate with heavy sea raining hard
at midnight blowing moderate gale Weather clear
at sunrise made sail wind at NW with heavy
running sea one sail in sight and with light
breeze at NW with pleasant Weather

Long 54 = 41

Remarks Tuesday Sept 17
first part light breeze from N by wind to
NW at midnight light breeze at E by E
at daylight wind at East light with pleasant
Weather steering NW by W one sail in
sight to Northward

Latt 34 = 04
Long 54 = 58

Remarks Wednesday Sept 18 1861
first part light air and calm middle light breeze
at East steering NW ends with light breeze at
SE with fine pleasant Weather

Latt 34 = 47
Long 61 = 09

Remarks Thursday Sept 19
this 24 hours moderate breeze from SE with
fine clear Weather steering of NW by W
part a Brig steering to N E

Latt 34 = 56
Long 63 = 03

Remarks Friday Sept 20
first of this 24 hours light at S with fine pleasant
Weather steering NW by W with all sail set middle
part light breeze at SE at midnight part a scho. steering
to SE latter part wind at NW steering NW by W
two sails in sight to Southward

Latt 35 = 33
Long 64 = 23

Remarks Saturday Sept 21
this 24 hours moderate breeze from the S W
with fine pleasant Weather steering of NW by W
at 4 am hove to the south for blackfish

Latt 36 = 19
Long 66 = 39
