

Remarks Sunday Sept 22 1861
first part strong from SW Weather pleasant
steering NW by W middle blowing strong at 11.30
light main sail took in flying kites with thick cloudy
Weather steering NW by W latter part same
at noon took heavy squall from SW split
the kites

Lat 37 = 19
Long 68 = 47

Remarks Monday Sept 23
first of this 24 hours blowing a strong breeze from SW
with thick strong squally Weather steering NW by W
at midnight wind hauled to Northward light
and baffling with drizzling rain at daylight wind
at NW light breeze with clear Weather by wind
heading NW by W 1/2 W saw a ship steering
to SE

Lat 37 = 55
Long 68 = 47

Remarks Tuesday Sept 24
first of this 24 hours light baffling wind from the
Northward with weather pleasant by wind to NW by W
all middle part same latter part strong breeze
from NE with drizzling rain steering NW by W

Lat 38 = 45
Long 64 = 43

Remarks Wednesday Sept 25 1861
first of this 24 hours strong breeze from NE with
fine Weather steering NW by W middle same latter
more moderate at noon sounded 93 fathoms

Lat 40 = 18

Remarks Thursday Sept 26
first of this 24 hours light breeze from NE with fine
pleasant Weather at 2 pm saw Long's land bearing
N by W distant 25 miles at sunset great West bay
light bearing N by W distant 20 miles all middle
and latter parts calm
