first part of this 24 hours strong breeze from SSW with pleasant weather by wind heading SW by W at 2 pm. toward three boats for blackfish struck two took them alongside all middle part moderate breeze at 8 with thick foggy weather under short sail heading WSW all latter part same

Friday May 23rd

fore part of this 24 hours light breeze at S heading WSW under all sail with fine pleasant weather at sunset took thunder squall from WSW at midnight wind at SW light under short sail heading S by E with fine weather at daylight made all sail with wind at WSW with fine weather at 6 am saw blackfish toward two for them

Saturday May 24th

first part of this 24 hours moderate breeze from SSW weather pleasant by wind to southward employed in boiling & out blackfish all middle calm with foggy weather at daylight Wind at NNE blowing a strong breeze steering S by E

Sunday May 25th

this 24 hours commences with strong breeze from NNE steering S by E at 6 pm took in flying jib & left mainsail blowing fresh with thick rainy with heavy sea running ends with moderate breeze at NE with weather thick and hazy

Monday May 26th

first of this 24 hours moderate breeze at SSW with thick rainy weather by wind heading WSW all middle and latter parts calm with thick rainy weather

Tuesday May 27th

first of this 24 hours moderate breeze at SSE with dark hazy weather heading to SW under short sail at 5 pm wore ship to Eastward at 8 pm took in foresail and flying jib blowing strong from south with heavy rain squalls ends with blowing a gale at SSE lying to under storm sails

Wednesday May 28

fore part of this 24 hours light breeze at SSW with heavy sea running hove to storm sails heading to SE all middle and latter parts calm with pleasant weather one sail in sight employed in ship's duty
