

Thursday June the 17th
 The first part of these 24 hours light
 breezes from S.W. set in at 2 P.M.
 but went ashore at sundown boat same as
 usual and set 6 sails as usual middle part
 strong breezes latter part at 5 P.M. put the
 sails in the main sail took in the fore sail
 and stood off shore to S.W. to anchor at
 10 miles in took in 10 ends

Friday June the 18th
 The first part of these 24 hours strong
 breezes from S.W. set off and in latter
 part more moderate with squalls of rain
 at 4 A.M. turned the reef out the main sail
 set the fore sail at 7 A.M. the boat went
 ashore 10 ends

Saturday June the 19th
 The first part of these 24 hours light breezes
 from Westward at 4 P.M. the boat with the
 Capt. having discharged the first Coffees.
 Tacked and stood to the Southward middle and
 latter part weather much the same 10 ends

Sunday June the 20th
 The first part of these 24 hours light
 breezes and fine weather from S.W.
 set by wind to S.E. middle and
 latter part much the same 10 ends
 Lat 29. 21
 Long 62. 45

Monday June the 21st
 The first part of these 24 hours light breezes from
 S.W. set by wind to S.E. middle part the same
 latter part strong breezes saw several seals
 steering to the N.E. hands employed repairing
 jib 10 ends
 Lat 29. 22
 Long 61. 01

Tuesday June the 17th 02
 The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes
 from S.W. set to S.E. at sundown took
 in fore jib and main sail and kept
 of S.E. middle part the same latter part
 equally at 8 A.M. wind veered to N.W.
 squally with a bad sea took in fore sail
 and jib set fore and main by sails
 and kept to E parted fore jib stay
 and spliced it again 10 ends
 Lat 28. 40
 Long 57. 44

Wednesday June the 18th
 The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes
 and a bad sea from N.W. set to E middle
 part wind veered to E at daylight set the
 the fore sail at 7 A.M. took to S.W.
 10 ends -
 Lat 28. 50
 Long 58. 42

Wednesday June the 18th
 The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes
 and a rough sea from E set to S.W. at sundown
 took in the fore sail and set the fore sail middle
 part the same at daylight set all sail
 wind hauled to S.E. more moderate
 10 ends
 Lat 29. 58
 Long 57. 41

Friday June the 20th
 The first part of these 24 hours good breezes
 and fine weather from S.E. set by wind to
 N.E. at sundown shortened sail at daylight
 set all sail at 6 A.M. saw sperm whales
 at 8 lowered Dec boats 10 ends
 Lat 30. 35
 Long 57. 50
