The first part of these 24 hours light breezes and fine weather from NW by W heading to the NE at 6 PM spoke s/s James Capt Rides clear at 8 PM Tacked to SE and went to SW latter part the same saw Porpoises so ends

The first part of these 24 hours good breezes and fine weather from SW by W wind to S at 4 PM spoke s/s James at 7 PM spoke Breeg Hopeton Capt Handy of Gipsian six weeks out 50 sperm middle and latter part moderate so ends

Thursday July the 3^d

The first part of these 24 hours light air from S by W wind to E & E one sail in sight at sundown shortened sail middle part calm at daylight set all sail light air from E s/s to S by W so ends

The first part of these 24 hours light air from E s/s to S by W at 1 PM saw Blackfish lowered one boat but did not see them again at 2 PM shot a Grampsey lowered a boat and got him at sundown shortened sail and more ship to NW at daylight made sail wind veered to E s/s to S by W so ends

Saturday July the 5th

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes from N s/s to W by N one sail in sight middle part the same at daylight kept off the S spoke s/s Emerald clear six weeks out so ends

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes from E s/s to S middle part much the same latter part calm saw Grampsey two sailer in sight so ends

Monday July the 7th

The first part of these 24 hours calm at sundown shortened sail middle part light breezes from SW s/s to NW at daylight made all sail at 7 AM Tacked to SE at 9 AM kept off to E by N so ends

Tuesday July the 8th

The first part of these 24 hours good breezes from S s/s to N by N at 4.30 PM saw sperm Whales at 6 PM lowered all three boats at 7 PM Starboard Boat struck at 8 PM took him alongside took in the foresail and lashed to S middle part moderate latter part at sunrise commenced cutting at 6 AM finished cutting at 8 AM Tacked to N so ends

Wednesday July the 9th

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from S by W s/s by wind to W heads employed cutting up and minding at sundown Tacked to E took in the mainsail and set main by sail at daylight set the mainsail hands employed minding and biding so ends

The first part of these 24 hours good breezes and fine weather from SW s/s by wind to S at 2 PM Tacked to W at 5 PM finished Baling and set the foresail middle and latter part much the same so ends
