The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from G. sch. by wind to N. N. E. at 2 P.M. spoke sch. Dolphin of N. Bedford 2 months out 30.1 per cent at sundown shortened sail spoke Brigg. Matamoras 2 months out clean middle part hauled to G. at daylight made sail at 6 A.M. hauled to N. E. several sails in sight so ends
