

Monday July the 21st 62
The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes
and squally weather from W schs to NE
at 1 Pm reced to E by S at 2 Pm took in the
Mainsail and the jib at sundown took in the
Goresail and set fore and main try sails at daylight
set the Goresail and reced to E so ends Lat 02.15
Long 48.00

Tuesday July the 22nd
The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes and
squally weather from W schs to E at sundown
took in the Goresail and set fore try sail middle
part squally with rain at sunrise set the Goresail
at 7 AM reced to NE latter part the same
so ends Lat 02.54
Long 47.32

Wednesday July the 23rd
The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes
from W schs to NE at 4 Pm reced to E
middle part squally and moderate at daylight
set the mainsail latter part light breezes and
fine weather so ends Lat 03.25
Long 46.20

Thursday July the 24th
The first part of these 24 hours light breezes
and fine weather from S W schs to E at 1 Pm
reced to E by S at sundown shortened sail
at daylight made all sail and luffed to SE
at 9 AM reced to E so ends Lat 03.21
Long 44.54

Friday July 25th
The first part of these 24 hours light breezes
and fine weather from S by S schs to E at
4 Pm reced to NE one sail in sight at sundown
shortened sail at daylight set all sail and luffed
to NE at merising Tacked to E by S so ends Lat 04.00
Long 44.12

Saturday July the 26th
The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from
W schs to E by S at 4 Pm spoke Barka Arab
of N B Capt. Nye 8 months out 300 yds also schs
Emerald of suspicion Capt Aldridge 2 months out
clear at sundown shortened sail and luffed to SE
at daylight made sail steering to the SE
latter part the same so ends Lat 04.00
Long 43.48

Sunday July 27th
The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes and
squally from W schs to SE at sundown
wind hauled to NE shortened sail and Tacked
to NE at daylight set all sail latter
part squally so ends Lat 04.18
Long 42.10

Monday July 28th
The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes and
squally weather from N W schs by wind to NE
at 4 Pm wind hauled to N at sundown shortened
sail at daylight set all sail squally weather from E
schs by wind to SE at 7 AM Tacked to NE
saw 3 sampuses one sail in sight steering to
the NE so ends Lat 04.40
Long 40.10

Tuesday July 29th
The first part of these 24 hours light breezes and
fine weather from E schs to NE by S middle part
much the same latter part wind hauled to NE
schs by wind to N N W saw 3 sampuses so ends
Lat 04.50
Long 38.50

Wednesday July the 30th
The first part of these 24 hours light breezes from NE
schs to N N W wind middle and latter part squally
with rain saw a plenty of 3 sampuses so ends
Lat 05.35
Long 44.54
