The first part of these 24 hours light breeze and squally weather from NE schs by wind to NE at sundown tacked to E and shortened sail for the night

middle part calm at daylight set all sail with light airs from E at 4 AM tacked to NE saw Grampuses two sails in sight steering to the NE so ends

Friday July 1st

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The first part of these 24 hours light airs from E schs to NE at sundown shortened sail at daylight set all sail wind hauled to E and saw a plenty of Grampuses so ends

Saturday Aug 2nd

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes from E and schs by wind to E at 10 PM saw 4 sperm whales hovered all three boats but could not get one at 6 PM came on board without success whales going quick to the NE middle and latter part moderate spoke schs Kingfisher of G & C Capt Lambert no gear out 100 sperm so ends

The first part of these 24 hours calm at sundown shortened sail middle and latter part light airs from E at daylight set all sail schs to E by N several sails in sight saw Grampuses and Whalers so ends

The first part of these 24 hours calm middle part light breezes from E schs by wind to E & C latter part good breezes several sails in sight saw Grampuses so ends

The first part of these 24 hours good breezes and fine weather from E schs to E & C saw Grampuses at sundown tacked to W and shortened sail at daylight set the fore strong breezes from E & W at 6 AM kept off to NE so ends

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from E & W schs to NE at 5 PM hauled to NE & saw breezes at sundown hauled under fore and main masts middle part squally at daylight set the fore and foresail latter part squally with a rough sea from W so ends

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes and squally weather from W tacked to E & W at sundown hauled to under two fore sails middle part heavy squally with rain latter part moderate gale with a heavy sea from E & W so ends

The first part of these 24 hours moderate gales from NE schs gave to heading to E with a heavy sea middle part squally with rain latter part much the same so ends
