The first part of these 24 hours strong gales from NW & W schs to E middle part squalls with rough sea latter part moderate at 11 AM wind veered to NW & at 12 noon ends

Thursday Aug 14th

The first part of these 24 hours squalls and fine weather from NW at 1 PM set all sail and kept off to NW & middle part calm latter part light breeze from NW & W schs by wind to NW & E ends

The first part of these 24 hours calm middle part the same latter part light breeze from NW & W schs to NW & ends
