The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes and squally weather from G.W. at 2 P.M. took in the ship's gill at 10 P.M. more moderate and the ship's gill and sheet the reef on the mainmast at midnight wind veered N. & backed to G.W. at 6 A.M. wind hauled to G.W. backed to G.W. so ends

Friday Sept 12th

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes and fine weather from G.W. by wind to W. & W. & middle and latter part much the same saw Blackfish so ends

Saturday Sept 13th

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes from G. & G. to W. & W. at sundown shortened sail middle part good breezes at daylight up to the ship's gill latter part strong breezes so ends

Sunday Sept 14th

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from G. & G. to W. & W. at sundown shortened sail and lifted to middle and latter part squally weather with heavy rain from G.W. so ends

Monday Sept 15th

The first part of these 24 hours rainy squally weather from G. & G. by wind to W. & W. middle and latter part rainy squally weather from W. so ends

Tuesday Sept 16th the first

part of these 24 hours squally weather from G.W. middle part the same latter part calm so ends

Wednesday Sept 16th 1862

The first part of these 24 hours calm middle part light breezes from E. & G. to N. & W. latter part good breezes and fine weather from G.W. & W. saw Porpoises so ends

Thursday Sept 17th

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes and fine weather from E. & G. to W. & W. middle part the same at daylight lifted to W. latter part strong breezes so ends

Lat 32. 25

Long 48. 80

Friday Sept 18th

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from E. & G. to W. middle part the same at 4 P.M. took in the main sail and set main trysail at 6 P.M. veered to W. & W. so ends

Lat 31. 33

Long 51. 00

Saturday Sept 19th

The first part of these 24 hours strong breezes from E. heading W. & W. at 6 P.M. took in the foresail and gill and lifted to W. & W. middle part the same at daylight set the gill and foresail at 7 A.M. veered to G. & G. latter part more moderate so ends

Lat 31. 50

Long 51. 46

Sunday Sept 20th

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes and fine weather from E. & G. at sundown took in the gill middle part calm latter part calm so ends

Lat 31. 21

Long 51. 06

Monday Sept 21st

The first part of these 24 hours light breeze from W. & W. at Northward middle part light breezes from N. & W. at daylight set all sail covered W. saw 3 porpoises so ends
