 These 24 hours continue with strong breezes
 S.W. steering E by S thick and rain
 5 A.M. Spoke Sch. James capt. McLean
 23 days out 1 B. fish. have to be under
 fore and main. try sail heading ESE
 blowing strong from S.W. Middle part
 part the same. Latter part thick
 and raining strong breezes at 11 A.M.
 a boat came on board from the
 James

 These 24 hours with strong breezes
 S.W. steering ESE Middle and latter
 part about the same Salt 31.17

Wednesday June 3rd
 These 24 hours calm with strong breezes

 Middle and latter part light winds
 S steering S.E. by E 1 sail in sight
 Salt 36.27

Thursday June 4th
 These 24 hours calm with light winds
 S steering S.E. by E raining Middle
 and latter part the same Salt 36.30
 Long 68.32

Friday June 5th
 These 24 hours calm with light winds
 and squally 1 sail in sight Middle
 part the same latter part pleasant
 Salt 31.60
 Long 67.31

Saturday June 6th
 These 24 hours calm with fine weather
 wind S steering to Eastward Salt 37.11
 Middle and latter part the same Long 66.28

Sunday June 7th 1863
 These 24 hours calm with light winds
 S.W. heading ESE Middle and latter part
 about the same Salt 31.16
 Long 65.61

Monday June 8th
 These 24 hours calm with strong breezes
 S heading ESE at 4 P.M. Spoke a
 English Bark Delaware from Baltimore
 at 7 put 2 rags in the mainsail Middle and
 latter parts the same Salt 31.65
 Long 62.33

Tuesday June 9th
 These 24 hours calm with strong breezes
 from S.W. steering ESE 1 sail in sight
 Middle and latter part about the same
 Salt 36.53
 Long 60.53

Wednesday June 10th
 These 24 hours calm with strong breezes
 to S.W. heading S.E. by E 2 P.M. took in
 the mainsail and flying jib quite ragged
 Middle and latter part squally and
 raining Salt 36.33

Thursday June 11th
 These 24 hours calm with strong breezes
 from S.W. running under short sail
 heading S.E. at sundown under 2 by sail
 Middle part the same latter part at
 sunrise wind S.W. pleasant made
 sail lashed ship heading S.E. steering
 S Salt 36.15
 Long 63.48

Friday June 12th These 24 hours calm with
 wind S.W. steering S pleasant Middle
 part the same latter part at
 daylight made all sail steering S.E.
 at 7 steering ESE S.W. M. Saw S.P.
