Sunday Aug 23rd

These 24 hours come with fine weather light breeze N. heading to Southward at sundown heading N. under all sail Middle and Satter part the same

Lat 37°33'

Long 42°53'

Monday Aug 24th

These 24 hours come with fine weather wind to steering S. N. at PM steering N. by S at sundown shortened by the wind heading E. Middle part the same Satter part wind E fine weather steering N. and S. under all sail

Lat 37°25'

Long 43°21'

Tuesday Aug 25th

These 24 hours come with fine weather wind steering N. S. N. at PM steering N. by N at sundown shortened sail by the wind heading N. E. Middle part the same Satter part wind N. E. light breeze steering N. under all sail

Lat 37°30'

Long 43°24'

Wednesday Aug 26th

These 24 hours come with fine weather light breeze N. E. steering S. at sundown shortened sail steering S. N. Middle part the same Satter part wind E steering N. S. N.

Lat 37°04' Long 43°27'

Thursday Aug 27th

These 24 hours come with fine weather wind steering N. S. N. at sundown shortened sail heading S. E. Middle part the same Satter part fine weather wind S. E. under all sail steering N. Lat 36°58' Long 43°30'

Friday Aug 28th 1863

These 24 hours come with fine weather wind S. E. steering N. S. N. at sundown shortened sail heading S. N. Middle part the same Satter part at sunrise made all sail heading S. N. at M. Spoke an English ship 80 days from Melbourne Australia bound to London at M. took ship heading S. E. Lat 36°54' Long 43°34'

Saturday Aug 29th

These 24 hours come with fine weather wind S. S. N. light air at sundown short sail Middle part the same Satter part fine weather light breeze S. N. steering N. S. N.

Lat 37°06' Long 43°37'

Sunday Aug 30th

These 24 hours fine weather light air S. N. steering N. S. N. at PM saw double fish took 1 small one at sundown short sail 1 sail in sight Middle part the same Satter part light air N. S. N. heading to the Eastward

Lat 37°14' Long 43°40'

Monday Aug 31st

These 24 hours light air at heading to Eastward at M. Spoke a Spanish Brig from Carthagena bound S. S. N. at sundown short sail heading to the N. Middle part the same Satter part light air heading to Westward 3 sails in sight Lat 37°33' Long 43°36'

Tuesday Sept 1st 1863

These 24 hours fine weather light air N. E. heading to Westward at PM Spoke an English ship 4 months from Bombay bound to England Middle and Satter part calm Lat 37°30' Long 42°35'
